## **MEETING NOTES**

- All in agreement that recreation teams should transition to age determination rather than grade determination for the 2024 season. A meeting will be scheduled in February to discuss the transition prior to registration opening.
- Registration fees per town:
  - Mansfield \$95 regular / \$120 late
  - Chesterfield \$150 regular/\$175 late; PreK & K \$125 regular / \$150 late
  - North Hanover \$35
  - Springfield \$75; PreK & K \$50
  - o Florence \$40
- JBMDL field locations Concerns regarding gaining access to base for games. All in agreement to schedule JBMDL games a few weeks into the season to allow time for gate access requirements to be worked out.
- Rostering
  - Mansfield holds assessments for 2<sup>nd</sup> grade & up; coaches select teams via draft. PreK through 1<sup>st</sup> rostered by coordinators.
  - Chesterfield requests soccer experience information via Team Sideline; coaches select teams based on the information provided.
  - Springfield coordinators handle all rostering.
  - North Hanover TBD.
  - All in agreement that travel players should be split equally among teams, if applicable.
- Training Programs
  - Mansfield is planning online and field training for coaches and increased player training programs.
  - Chesterfield offers coach and player training. John Kelly offered to provide a Buildout Line training session to all towns.
- Referees
  - Townships to consider paying referee fees in advance for efficiency and to alleviate the financial burden to NBSC.
- Games
  - Games will begin on September 9<sup>th</sup>.

- Boys' rec games on Saturday mornings do not conflict with Sunday travel games.
- Keith suggested moving girls' rec games to Friday nights to not conflict with travel games.
- Mansfield and Chesterfield are currently considering light pole rentals.
- No games are held on Columbus Day and Teachers Convention weekend.
- Shawn Fitzpatrick & Tony Bifulco will manage game scheduling.
- PreK and K games are traditionally scheduled internally. Commissioners may choose to coordinate games among other NB towns for these levels.
- Chesterfield hosts Turkey Cup tournament the weekend prior to Thanksgiving. Open to inviting all NB towns to join.
- North Hanover is considering a Kick-or-Treat Tournament for Halloween.
- Rules of Play
  - Available on the NBSC website, <u>www.northernburlingtonsoccerclub.com</u>, under recreation league schedules. (Copy attached.)
  - A request was made to change wording on Game Play rule #13 to allow teams to borrow registered players from a lower-level team from the same township when they lack the minimum number of players to field a team.
- Coaching Certifications
  - Chesterfield using NAYS Online Training. Mansfield to research to see if this is an option to replace the RUTGERS Clinic.
- NB Soccer Club Recreation Subcommittee
  - Includes 2 representatives from each sending district + JBMDL and Florence Twp.
  - Has a Recreation Trust account. Needs a treasurer.
  - Increased communication and financial transparency requested.
