**RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING THE AWARD OF A  
“REQUIRED DISCLOSURE” CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE AND  
INSTALLATION OF ONE (1) DAIKIN 18,000 BTU HEAT PUMP AND ONE (1) DAIKIN  
9,000 BTU HEAT PUMP FOR THE POLICE STATION DATA ROOM AND STORAGE  
ROOM AS IDENTIFIED IN PROPOSAL SUBMITTED BY LIBERTY MECHANICAL  
SERVICES**

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Mansfield has the need to purchase and install one (1) Daikin 18,000 BTU Heat Pump and one (1) Daikin 9,000 BTU Heat Pump for the Police Station Data Room and Storage Room; and

**WHEREAS**, as permitted by the New Jersey Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A: 11-3. since the anticipated amount of the contract did not exceed the statutory maximum of \$44,000, the Township Qualified Purchasing Agent authorized the award of a contract for the purchase and installation of one (1) Daikin 18,000 BTU Heat Pump and one (1) Daikin 9,000 BTU Heat Pump for the Police Station Data Room and Storage Room to Liberty Mechanical Services (“Vendor”) as a “Required Disclosure” contract based on proposals pursuant to the aforesaid statutory provisions; and

**WHEREAS**, Contractor has performed services, to date, in the amount of \$12,489 and has submitted a proposal dated January 25, 2022, that additional services required will be approximately \$11,550 and the total amount of the Contract will exceed the \$17,500 statutory maximum in the aggregate set forth in N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5, concerning eligibility for municipal contracts; and

**WHEREAS**, the anticipated term of this contract is one (1) year from July 19, 2022 but in no event shall the total amount of the contract amount exceed the bid threshold of \$44,000 pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:34-8.1(b); and

**WHEREAS**, LIBERTY MECHANICAL SERVICES has submitted a proposal dated January 25, 2022, indicating they will provide and install one (1) Daikin 18,000 BTU Heat Pump and one (1) Daikin 9,000 BTU Heat Pump for the Police Station Data Room and Storage Room; and

**WHEREAS**, to satisfy the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5, concerning eligibility for municipal contracts, Vendor has completed and submitted a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies that LIBERTY MECHANICAL SERVICES has not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee in the Township of Mansfield and has not made any reportable contributions to the following elected officials; Mayor Marcial Mojena, Deputy Mayor Rudy Ocello, Committeeman Robert Tallon, Committeeman Daniel Golenda or Committeeman Brian Sisz in the previous one year, and that the contract will prohibit LIBERTY MECHANICAL SERVICES from making any reportable contributions through the term of the contract, and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Financial Officer, Bonnie J. Grouser, has certified that sufficient funds are available to award said contract; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Governing Body of the Township of Mansfield authorizes the Qualified Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with LIBERTY MECHANICAL SERVICES as described herein; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Business Entity Disclosure Certification and the Determination of Value be placed on file with this Resolution, and
