**NEW BUSINESS:**

1. *Planning and Zoning Board Application re: 1177 Jacksonville-Hedding Rd., Bl. 43, Lot 2.04*

Dan Caldwell and the board have reviewed the application and unanimously have agreed that the waiver for the EIS cannot be granted. Although partial waiver for the up and downstream sampling will be given. Also, because of the nature of the business, there are concerns as to the potential use of chemicals, pesticides, fertilizer, and potential green house, the applicant needs to provide more information as to the plan for running and operation of the flower shop business.

Further, the board is concerned about the applicant’s plans as to the septic, set up and usage. Question 18 on the application asks if the applicant proposes a well and septic system was answered “NO”. Applicant needs to address this further. What will be washed out from the flower shop? What will the applicant use to clean containers? Which chemicals will be used?

Bob Tallon made a motion to have Dan Caldwell advise the Planning Board of the above mentioned concerns with regard to this application. Mark Clark seconded the motion. The remaining members approved the motion. The motion passed.
