### Electronics

- Computers & Laptops
- Monitors, Keyboards & Mice
- Printers & Scanners
- Telephones & Modems
- Television Sets
- DVD Players, Gaming Devices, Stereos

### Brush

- Shrub Trimmings
- Hedge Clippings
- Branches not larger than 4" in diameter or 4 feet in length
- Leaves (if in approved leaf bags)

### Co-Mingled Recyclables

- Paper and Cardboard
- Plastic Bottles and Containers labeled with numbers 1, 2 or 5
- Glass Bottles & Jars
- Metal Cans



### Other Items

- Household Trash
- Metal & Scrap
- Car Batteries

## Not Accepted

- Grass Clippings
- Tree stumps or trunks
- Tree parts from below ground level
- Hazardous Waste
- Paint, household chemicals & pesticides
- Prescription and over-the-counter medications
- Explosives & Weapons
- Air Conditioners
- Household Batteries
- Fireworks
- Fluorescent Bulbs
- Motor Oil
- Tires
- Smoke Detectors
- Waste from commercial, industry or small businesses (even if business owned by Mansfield Resident)

- Starting Fall 2021, there are no set pickup days. Public Works will come around multiple times from October 18<sup>th</sup> thru December 1<sup>st</sup>.
